Step 1: Realize God Loves You.

<p><u>Deuteronomy 7:7,8 (KJV)</u></p> <p>⁷ The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people:</p> <p>⁸ But because the LORD loved you...</p>	<p><u>John 3:16 (KJV)</u></p> <p>¹⁶ For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.</p>

Step 2: Realize everyone is a sinner.

<p><u>Psalms 14:2,3 (KJV)</u></p> <p>² The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.</p> <p>³ They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one.</p> <p><u>Ecclesiastes 7:20 (KJV)</u></p> <p>²⁰ For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.</p>	<p><u>Romans 3:23 (KJV)</u></p> <p>²³ For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;</p>

Step 3: Realize sin has a price and must be paid.

<p><u>Genesis 2:17 (KJV)</u></p> <p>¹⁷ But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.</p> <p><u>Ezekiel 18:20 (KJV)</u></p> <p>²⁰ The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him.</p>	<p><u>Romans 6:23 (KJV)</u></p> <p>²³ For the wages of sin is death;</p>

Step 4: Realize Jesus Christ died and rose again to pay for your sin.

<p><u>Isaiah 53:9,10,12 (KJV)</u></p> <p>¹² Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.</p> <p><u>Psalms 30:3 (KJV)</u></p> <p>³ O LORD, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.</p>	<p><u>Romans 5:8 (KJV)</u></p> <p>⁸ But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.</p> <p><u>Romans 14:9 (KJV)</u></p> <p>⁹ For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living.</p>

<p><u>Joel 2:32 (KJV)</u></p> <p>³²And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.</p> <p><u>Isaiah 55:3 (KJV)</u></p> <p>³ Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.</p>	<p><u>Romans 10:9 (KJV)</u></p> <p>⁹ That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.</p> <p><u>John 3:15 (KJV)</u></p> <p>¹⁵That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.</p>
